




OUR MISSION

CAROLINA EXPERIENCE PEER LEADERS (CEPLs)

- 15 hired and trained for the current academic year
- Variety of academic colleges/majors, transfer, and off-campus students
- Every undergraduate student past the first year is assigned a CEPL (~1200: 1)
- · Through early fall, all student populations are represented in consultations
- Focus Areas:
 - Peer to Peer Approach
 - Referrals to Campus Resources
 - Beyond the Classroom Engagement Exploration and ties to Academic Major/Career

CONSULTATION RESULTS

- 98% stated their Peer Leader was knowledgeable and listened to their concerns.
- 98% stated they learned something new.
- 98% stated their consultation was helpful.
- 96% would recommend a consultation to peers.

 - Engineering and Computing




Dedicated technologies support role in SAAS (Liz Carmon, **Director of Student Success Projects)**
