



## How to Apply as a Change of Campus Student

A change of campus student is a person who is currently enrolled at another USC campus, and wishes change their home campus to USC Lancaster. If you have missed a Fall or Spring semester (or longer), you will be classified as a readmit student rather than a change of campus student. Please note that students must be in good standing with their respective campus, and are not eligible to change USC campuses while serving a suspension.

- ✓ Complete the online application
- ✓ Requirements for enrollment:
  - Additional information such as, but not limited to, the following may be requested as university policy and procedures are updated on a regular basis:
    - Updated immunization form and acceptable proof of immunization
    - Updated citizenship verification form and acceptable proof of citizenship
    - Updated South Carolina residency verification form
- ✓ Admission
  - Once all required credentials have been submitted, your application will be reviewed and processed. You will receive notification of our decision by mail.
- ✓ Claiming Your Account
  - Your acceptance packet will include your VIP ID and a temporary password, along with instructions that you will need to follow in order to finish setting up your account.
    - If you have previously set up your account with another USC campus, you will not need to re-claim your account.
- ✓ Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
  - If you plan to receive financial aid other than the LIFE scholarship, you will need to complete a FAFSA for USC Lancaster's campus, or add USCL to one you have previously submitted.
