






Critical Needs for Bachelor's Degrees

Education Needs Index for South Carolina




Level of Education Need

South Carolina Educational attainment – persons 25 and over – percent bachelor's degree or higher, 2005-2009 by county







2013-2014 Palmetto College *Online* by the Numbers



- **8192** potential students *inquired* between April 18, 2013 – December 31, 2014



- **689** students currently enrolled as Palmetto College *majors* in Fall semester 2014



- **1,015 majors** enrolled from Fall 2013-Fall 2014



- **5,936** seats filled in **209** Palmetto College *online courses* Fall 2013 – Fall 2014


- **241 degrees conferred** in Year 1 (Fall 2013-Fall 2014)



- **Growth rate projected** at 25% to 50% in 2014-2015:
750 -1000 total students (Huron 2011, 2012; Kennedy 2013, 2014)
